

Credit for carbon saving

A GLASGOW-BASED company has been named a finalist in an awards scheme for reducing carbon footprints.

Mabbett and Associates, an environmental and engineering company, has made it to the finals of the Carbon Trust Low Carbon Building Award.

It aims to recognise the significant carbon saving potential within the building sector, specifically looking at environmental impact, particularly energy demand and emissions and sustainability.

M&A purchased a B-listed sandstone terraced property in Glasgow city centre to create their main office, aiming to utilise what the building already had to offer as much as possible.

John Stocks, manager of Carbon Trust Scotland, said: "M&A challenges the myth that energy efficiency is not possible in listed Georgian townhouses.

"By refurbishing this 1850s property using a range of technologies, they have demonstrated what can be done."
